

Hi! Thanks for wanting to give the *Save Our Seas* presentation. We are thrilled there are kids out there like YOU who are helping to save our oceans. Here is the information you will need to put on a great presentation to your class, school, scout troupe, sports team, church group, or anybody else who you think will listen.

Key Items to Know:

- The Save Our Seas presentation is a PDF document that can be shown on any computer using Adobe Acrobat Reader (which can be downloaded for free from www.adobe.com if you don't have it). There is also a separate animation file (FluffyAnimation.mp4) that you may be able to use in conjunction with Slide 30.
- Having your computer hooked to a projector works best for a strong and easy visual impact for your audience.
- The Save Our Seas script is a separate PDF document. Be sure and download this document as well. Take time to rehearse it several times before giving it to your group, so you are comfortable with all the words and information. Remember to speak slowly, so your audience can understand everything you are saying. Be energetic and have fun.
- The presentation is most effective when you can give students a *Think Ocean* card and *Seafood Watch Pocket Guide* at the end of the presentation. Our *Think Ocean* cards (PDF document) can easily be downloaded and printed (they are two-sided).
- You can call or email the Monterey Bay Aquarium Seafood Watch program and they will send you plenty of Seafood Watch Pocket Guides for your presentation.
